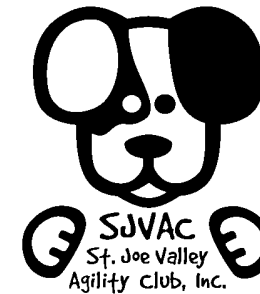

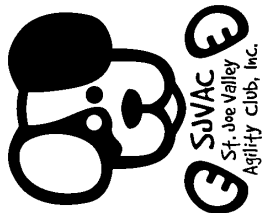

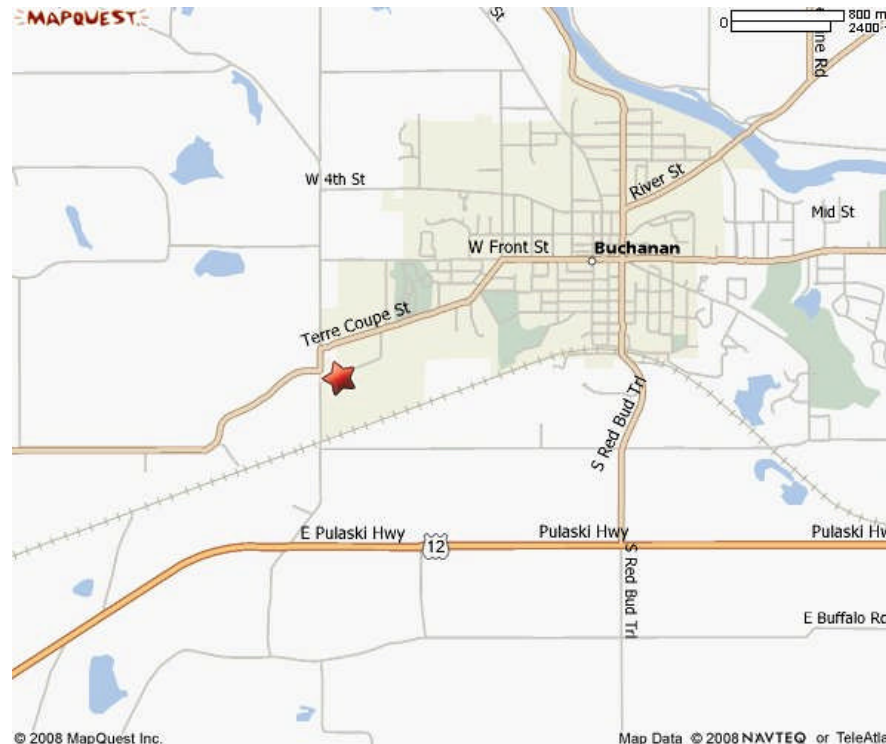

**Directions to Show Site:**

**From West:** (From New Buffalo, MI) I-94 to Exit 4A, US 12 East to Bakertown Rd. (approximately five miles east of Galien.) Turn left (north) on Bakertown.

**From North, South & East:** Take US 31 / 20 Bypass to Exit 3, US 12 in Michigan. Go west approximately four miles to Bakertown Rd. Turn right (north) on Bakertown.

**Once on Bakertown Road,** go north one mile to Post Road. The ECHO building and grounds are on the southeast corner of Bakertown and Post Roads.

**Directions:**

Bakertown Rd. south to US 12 east (turn left). Take US 12 east. Take US 31 south (toward South Bend) 4.7 miles. Exit Cleveland Road. Turn east (left) onto Cleveland Road. Take Cleveland Rd. to Grape (approx. 8 miles). At Grape, turn south (right) 3 miles. Clinic is on the left just before you get to US 20. (approx. 35 minutes)

**SHOW HOURS:**

7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Eastern time (Michigan time). The building will be open between these times. **Judging will begin at 8:30 a.m.**

**NOTE:** Building will NOT be available for exhibitor setup before day of show.

Obedience trial will be held indoors. Climate controlled building -- one ring, completely matted, limited crating indoors

**ENTRY FEES:** (Includes \$3.00 for AKC Event Service fee each entry and \$0.50 recording fee on first entry)

**Separate fee for each dog, each day, each trial**

**First entry of each dog ..... \$25.00**  
**Additional entry of same dog ..... \$19.00**

**ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY, NOON, July 29, 2009**, unless limits are reached prior to this date. Any entries received after the published closing date or after the limits have been reached will be returned. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received in writing or via e-mail prior to the closing of entries, and must include AKC number and breed of dog.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show committee.

**MAKE CHECKS and money orders payable to SJVAC, INC.** (returned check charge \$20.00). All checks must have obedience class entered written on the face. **THIRD PARTY CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS**, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front and back will be accepted if legible, and of official AKC size. A single entry form may be used for both days only if the information is the same for both days. To use the enclosed entry form, check the appropriate boxes for each show in which you wish to enter your dog.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:**

No exhibitor setup before day of show.  
Limited crate space. No Exercise pens in the building.  
Exhibitors must pick up after their dog(s).  
No Bitches in season in the building.  
Dogs must be at least six months old on the day of the trial.  
Show site is handicapped accessible.  
Indoor restroom facilities are available and are handicapped accessible.  
No space provided for unentered dogs.  
No charge for parking; admission for spectators is free.  
Please turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering the ring.  
The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

**Waiver of Rights**

All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against St. Joe Valley Agility Club or its member, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

AKC and SJVAC, Inc. are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or nonprescription drugs will be allowed on the grounds or while participating in events. AKC and SJVAC, Inc. assume no responsibility for any damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, lightning, tornadoes or extreme heat must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Move-up requests must include Owner/Handler name, name of dog, AKC Registration number, email address, class(es) entered, and move-up class(es). Move-up confirmations will be sent by email only. You must supply a valid email address to receive a confirmation. If you don't receive a reply, your move-up request was not received. The Trial Secretary is not responsible for undelivered move-up requests.
